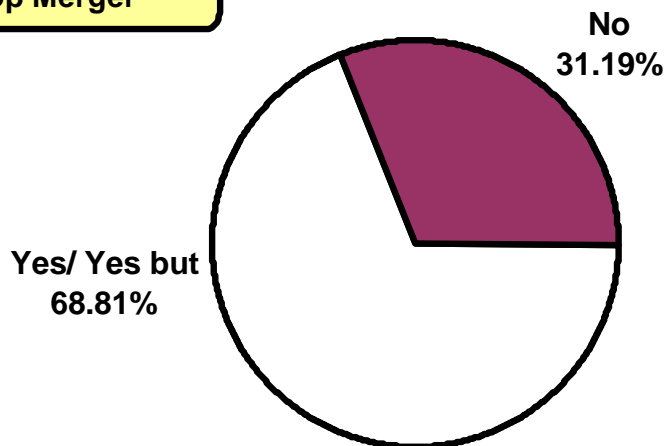




Ballot of South Devon Co-operatives Feb 2003 On the Proposed Co-op Mergers

TOTAL YES/YES BUT 69% (75)

TOTAL NO 31% (34)

I therefore declare that the ballot held to decide on the question whether the three existing co-operatives, namely Baydoc, Templerdoc and Seadoc, should combine from 1st April 2003 has been carried in all three areas individually and overall. The new arrangements will start as planned with an initial three month period when the three existing treatment centres will continue to function before a review as to whether both the Newton Abbot and Teignmouth centres shall continue to be maintained.
